State Pension Application of Thomas Owen VAS100

I DO with the advice of the Council hereby certify, that Ann Owen widow of Thomas Owen who was a private in the first Regiment of Artillery and died in the service of The United States is entitled to the sum of Twelve Pounds yearly; which allowance is to commence from the first day of January 1786

GIVEN under my hand as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, at Richmond, (the Governor being absent) this 15th day of June 1787
