Mathew Scott Serj't. in the 8th Virginia Reigt. having served three years in the Continental Service the Term for which he was inlisted is hereby Discharged Given under my hand at Petersburg this 15th of Dec'r. 1779

Richmond 25 May 1784

This is to Certify that I Mathew Scott of Lincoln County [KY] have Bargain'd & sold unto William Scott of the said County all my Rights, Claims, interest, or Demands whatsoever against the public for services done in the Continental Army & I do hereby Authorise the said William Scott to receive & settle with the Auditors of Public Acco'ts for the same he having paid me for the clame, the receipt whereof I do hereby Acknowledge in testemoney whereof I have hereunto Set My Hand this Twenty Seventh day of February 1784.
