This is to Certify that George Day Inlisted with me the 10<sup>th</sup> February one thousand seven hundred and seventy seven to serve the term of Three years which term of three years he discharged his duty truly and faithfully and is hereby Discharged. Given under my hand this 1<sup>st</sup>[?] day of February one thousand seven hundred and Eighty

I do hereby Authorize and Impower Mr. Samuel Blackwell to draw all the Wages due me from the Commisary[?] for my Service in the Navy, for the [several illegible words] also my Land Warrant, as Witness my hand this 27<sup>th</sup> day of November 1783. George hisXmark Day

NOTE: The 1820 federal census of Northumberland County VA lists George Day as head of a household of free people of color.
