NOTE: No application was found in the file, but a letter in the file of James Nickens VAS1127 states that one was filed on behalf of James Nickens, one of the heirs of James and Hezekiah Nickens. The 1830 federal census of Frederick County lists James Nickens as head of a household of free persons of color.
