Prince George, [illegible abbreviation]

This day Isham Valentine came before me & made oath that he has lost his Soldier Discharge.
given under my Hand this 14 of Dec'r. ADom 1784 Isaac Hall.

The above Isham Valentine was a Soldier in my regiment, to the Northward, was at Middlebrook in 1779
and was captured at Charlestowne [Charleston SC, probably 12 May 1780], I cannot ascertain[?] his
particular period of service but remember he was several years in the Army.
Dec'r. 15 1784 William Davies

I Certify that Capt. Wm. Epes [William Epes] was an Officer in my Regmt and in Capt. Jones Comp'y.
and it is probable I discharged Valentine

Sir/ Isham Valentine a Soldier that was in Capt. Jones Comp'y. was enlisted the 12 Sept. 77 for three
years and says by you Dischar[ged] him the Time I can not say. Wm Epes
