Virginia Pension Claim of John Dye VAS1169

[From [pension claims in the Library of Virginia](#). The online file of John Dye contains mostly papers of Reuben Earthen VAS1168. The one image relating to John Dye is fragmented and meaningless. One document indicates that Sarah Ann Dye was pensioned on 3 Feb 1812 at \$40 per year, presumably as the widow of John Dye, who must have been killed in service. Another paper dated 16 Nov 1814 refers to Sarah D. Dye, administrator in the estate of Sarah A. Dye, having received the final pension payment of \$38.32 up to the time of the latter's death. The online index for John Dye states that the pension was paid in Lancaster County.]
