Virginia Pension Claim of James Edmonds VAS1243

I do with advice of Council hereby certify that Sarah Edmonds, widow of James Edmonds who was a sailor in the Navy of this Commonwealth and died in the service of the same, is continued on the list of Pensioners with an allowance of eight pounds yearly commencing the first day of January One thousand seven hundred and ninety three.

Given under my hand as Lieutenant Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia at Richmond in the absence of the Governor, this 27<sup>th</sup> day of June 1795.
