I Alexander C Shackelford [possibly Alexander Shackelford, pension application S7506] of the county of King & Queen state of Virginia being now in the 74<sup>th</sup> year of my age do certify and declare that I was well acquainted with William Edwards of Gloucester County that he enlisted in Capt Michen Boswells [sic: Machen Boswell, pension application R19364] company of the second state regiment of the revolutionary war commanded by Col. Wm Brent [William Brent] that he was at the battle of monmouth [28 Jun 1778] that he served for three years in the revolutionary war and untill the end of the war and was honourably discharged as witness my hand and seal this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June 1833
