These are to Certify that the Bearer hereof James Fitzpatrick in the first Virg'a. Reg't. having faithfully served the United states from the 8<sup>th</sup> of January 1777 to this date and being Enlisted for the war is hereby discharged from the American Army

Given at the war office the 7<sup>th</sup> of July 1783 by order of the Secretary at war
