Virginia Bounty-Land Claim of Joel Foster VAS1402



February 23rd 1809

I Certify that Joel Foster was a Soldier in the Continental Army for three years and served under me for part of the time then detached to the Southward under Colo Buford and was wounded in the action call'd. Bufords Defeat [defeat of Abraham Buford at the Battle of Waxhaws SC, 29 May 1780] and never joined me again

NOTES:

Hezekiah Morton (BLWt69-300) was a Captain in the 8th Virginia Continental Regiment. John L. Crute (S24980) was an Ensign at the Battle of Waxhaws.

The bounty-warrant file includes a typed transcription of the federal pension application of a different Joel Foster (W11008) inscribed, "Presented by Dr. L. S. Foster of Williamsburg, 4/16/23."
