Point of Fork [at present Columbia VA] 6<sup>th</sup> Ap'1 1784

I do hereby Certify that John Foster Inlisted the 8 day of March one thousand seven hundred and eighty one to serve three years in the Virg'a. Con'l. line agreeable to the Register of the Regiment now in my possession Given under my hand the date and [illegible word] above.
