

I do Certify to the best of my knowledge, that Nath. Fox decd. of King Wm. [King William] County Served in the 7th Virginia Reg't. in the last Revolutionary War as a Second Lieutenat during the term of three years and upwards, given under my hand this 3rd day of December 1809

King & Queen County 20th August 1809

This will certify that Nathaniel Fox of King William County entered into the 7th Virg'a Regiment in the year 1776; his rank I have forgotten nor do I recollect when Mr. Fox resigned or whether he did at all 'til the end of the War, but to the best of my recollection he did resign before the war terminated. By a reference to the Muster Rolls of the 7th Regiment the above circumstance can certainly be ascertained.

Given under my hand the date above Henry Young [probably BLWt2466-300]
