To the auditor of publick accou[nts] Richmond sir please to give the [with]in Robert Given an order to the Tres[urer] of Virginia for the sum of fifty Do[llars] Which the general assembly of Last yea[r] allowed me as a pention and you w[ill] much oblige your friend
