Virginia Pension Claim of Thomas Hightower VAS1724

Mr. Hightower ought to obtain a Certificate from Col [Robert] Goode (or his commanding officer) whether he was wounded while in the Continental or state Service

I Do Certifie that the above ment'd. Thomas Hightower was Wounded when under my Com'd. In the Militia Given under my hand this 6<sup>th</sup> Dec 1781 [signed] Robt. Goode

Sep'r. 11<sup>th</sup> 1788 Rec'd. of J Harris DS. [Deputy Sheriff] the full of the within Order  
Thos Hightower

NOTE: The last document in the file is an order by the Court of Amelia County VA in Feb 1782 for the Sheriff to pay Thomas Hightower his pension.
