
[Methodology: Spelling, punctuation and/or grammar have been corrected in some instances for ease of reading and to facilitate searches of the database. Where the meaning is not compromised by adhering to the spelling, punctuation or grammar, no change has been made. Corrections or additional notes have been inserted within brackets or footnotes. Blanks appearing in the transcripts reflect blanks in the original. A bracketed question mark indicates that the word or words preceding it represent(s) a guess by me. Only materials pertinent to the military service of the veteran and to contemporary events have been transcribed. Affidavits that provide additional information on these events are included and genealogical information is abstracted, while standard, 'boilerplate' affidavits and attestations related solely to the application, and later nineteenth and twentieth century research requests for information have been omitted. I use speech recognition software to make all my transcriptions. Such software misinterprets my southern accent with unfortunate regularity and my poor proofreading fails to catch all misinterpretations. Also, dates or numbers which the software treats as numerals rather than words are not corrected: for example, the software transcribes "the eighth of June one thousand eighty six" as "the 8th of June 1786." Please call errors or omissions to my attention.]

I do Certify that William Phillips was a Soldier in the revolutionary Army of the United States that he enlisted under Ensign John Dudley in the year 1776 and that he was in the service during the war.

This day Henry Phillips came before me a Justice of the Peace for the aforesaid County and made oath to the above Certificate

I do hereby Certify that William Phillips Enlisted for 3 years under John Dudley and Ensign in the 6th Virginia Regiment in the year 1776 and that he was in the service at the Siege of York 1781.
