Bounty-Land Claim for Service of Charles Harris VAS2

Charlotte County Sct

This day Robert Harris William T. Smith & William Paylor came before me one of the Commonwealth's Justices of the Peace for the County aforesaid and made oath that they served in the 14<sup>th</sup> Virginia Regiment with Charles Harris that the said Charles Harris enlisted for three years in the continental line and died in the State of Pennsylvania at the Yellow springs Hospital – in consequence of which he could not serve his time of enlistment out. And these deponents further state that they believe the said Charles Harris nor his representatives has never drawn his land bounty nor his full pay – Given under my hand this second day of March 1812
