
Virginia documents pertaining to Britton Jones VAS2044

To the Honorable the Speakers and Members of the General Assembly the petition of Britton Jones humbly Sheweth.

That in the year 1782 your petitioner was drafted from the Militia of the County of Greenville to perform a tour of duty of Six Months – that he did perform the said duty in the Town of Portsmouth for the said term and at the expiration thereof obtained a discharge and certificate of his Service from Captain Armstead his Commander, which your Petitioner has ready to produce.

Your petitioner begs leave to state to your Honorable House, that no Compensation has been yet made him for his Services, and prays that the Auditor of public Accounts (who certifies that his Claim has not been liquidated) may be directed to issue to him a Certificate for the amount thereof. And as in duty bound He will pray
