Sarah Martin be put upon * pention [list] agreeable to a certificate given by the said Capt'n *
By order of Court/ teste John Evans CMC

I do certify that to my own knowledge the within mentioned Sarah Martin is very old, & believed
above sixty years of age and in very indigent circumstances – possessing very [litt]le property of any kind
– Given under my hand this 15 day of Dec'r. 1786 David Lea*
put on List with £8/ C Blair

I do with the advice of the Council hereby Certify that Sarah Martin widow of William Martin who was a
private in the 13th Virginia Regiment and died in the service of the United States, Is allowed the sum of
Eight Pounds yearly to commence from the first day of January 1786.
