William Nale alias William Nagle having made Satisfactory proof of his being still alive which is  
Ordered to be Certified to the Governor & Council of this Commonwealth, and it is Ordered that the  
Sheriff pay him Fifty Dollars the amount of his pension due for the last year out of the revenue tax for  
1811
