Received a Warrant of Forty Dollars pursuant to An Act of Assembly passed the present Session
9 Feb'y 1800

A handwritten signature in cursive script, appearing to read "Wm Rice".

Richmond County Court the 6th day of February 1809.
On the motion of William Rice a Public pensioner It is ordered that the Sherif pay his pension of Sixty
dollars for the last year Copy Teste B. McCarty CRC

Richmond County Court April the 4th 1815
On the motion of Richard Efford adm'or of William Rice dec'd. which said Rice was a public pensioner,
and died on or about the 10th day of November last, ordered that the Sheriff pay to the said administrator
at the rate of Sixty dollars pr year to the time of the death of the said Rice, for his pension last year.
