[The following are from [pension records in the Library of Virginia](#). Most of the documents are partly missing from the online images. The first document is a power of attorney executed in Lee County VA on 26 Feb 1819 by Daniel Smith for the purpose of collecting his pension as a "Military invalid." The file contains similar powers of attorney and other documents renewed annually, but none provides information about Daniel Smith's service or wound. The final document is a receipt dated 6 Jan 1803.]

Virginia we find that his disability still continues And further that the degree of disability under which he now labours is not less than the original degree of disability for which he was first placed upon the pension list In testimony whereof we have subscribed our names this 5th day of Sept. 1825
