Mr. Samuel Shepperd Auditor Richmond

Sir Please to deliver to Mr Charles Gee a warrent on the Treasury for my pension of forty dollars allowed me by an act of assembly past in January 1809 your Compliance will oblige your Hum'l. Serv't.

Liddia herXmark Tackett

Teste/ Jesse Hustlewhite

This 5<sup>th</sup> day of January 1810

Prince George Cty Sct This day Jesse Hustlewhite appeared before me a justice of the peace for the County aforesaid and made oath that he & said Liddia Tackett aknowledge the above order to be her act & saw her subscribe her mark thereto

Given under my hand this 5<sup>th</sup> day of January 1810

NOTE: The file contains other documents similar to the above, the last being signed by Lydia Tackett by her mark on 25 Dec 1821. The file contains a document dated December 1821 certifying that Elizabeth Tackett was administrator of the estate of Lydia Tackett.
