

Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

Virginia documents pertaining to Jacob Tanner VAS2127
Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris.

I do with advice of the Council of State Certify that Dorothy Tanner widow of Jacob Tanner late a Soldier in the State line, who died in Service of the State is placed on the Pension list agreeably to Act of Assembly, with the yearly allowance of Eight Pounds Commencing the 18th day of December last.

Given under my hand as Governor at Richmond this 27th day of November 1795.

[signed] R Brooke

At a Court Continued & held for Madison County on Friday the 26th day of Octr 1798 in the 23^d year of the Commonwealth.

Ordered that the Sheriff pay unto Dorothy Tanner (Widow of Jacob Tanner late a Soldier in the state line, who died in Service of the State) Eight pounds out of the Revenue Tax for the year, one thousand seven hundred & ninety seven it being the amount of her Pension for the year 1797.
