Surry County April Court 1789

Mildred Williams widow of Lewis Williams who enlisted a private in the fourth Virginia Regiment on Continental establishment came personally into Court and produced a Certificate for an allowance of six pounds per annum to which she made oath as the law directs. Ordered therefore that the Sheriff of the County do pay the said six pounds out of his collection of taxes, made this present year

1789 July 14th Receiv'd of Willaim Salter Sheriff six pounds in full of the within Order.
