


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

This is to Certify that Rich'd Call esquire commanded as a Maj'r in the Cavalry in the Army of the united states in the Campaign of 1782 and I believe he held his command till the end of the revolutionary war. I further believe that he was appointed a Captain when the first Regiment of Cavalry was established and that his services were continued from that time till the end of the War.
