

I do hereby Certify that Mr. Thomas Wallace served first as an Ensign, and afterwards as Lieutenant in the 8<sup>th</sup> Virginia Regiment, from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1779 'til the 4<sup>th</sup> day of May 1782.

Given under my hand this 22<sup>d</sup> day of October 1790.
