Virginia documents pertaining to William Grey VAS2217

[The following are from [rejected claims in the Library of Virginia](#):]

I Thomas R Dunn aged 65 years, of Warwick county do hereby certify that I was acquainted with Tho. [Thomas Allen VAS2215] and William Allen [VAS2216], William Grey and Anthony Maurice [VAS2218], who were all from the said county and know that some time during the year 1780 or 1781 they each and all enlisted in the continental service, during the Revolutionary war as privates and that they were engaged in service to the south. I recollect distinctly that they were engaged to the south during the siege of York [Yorktown, 28 Sep - 19 Oct 1781] and did not return from service until some time after the said siege. the said Antho. Maurice died while in service. The other three above persons returned to Warwick where they lived when they enlisted, and remained until they died
