This day Came Philip Snead [pension application S38392], Elisha Winn [S38477] and Joseph Bohannon [Joseph Bohannon] Before me Alex'r Winn one of the Commonwealths Justices of the peace for the County aforesaid and made oath that William Allen was Inlisted in the Regular Continental Service by Captain James Johnson in the 6<sup>th</sup> Virginia Regiment [one or two undeciphered words] the said Snead Winn & Bohannon was, & that he the said Allin Served the Same terms of Service [undeciphered word] and in the said Company & Regiment and that he also Perform'd this Tower of duty according to Law. Given under my hand this fourth day August 1810.
