Westmoreland County State of Virginia To Wit

Be it remembered that Before me [undeciphered name] Justice of the peace in and for the county aforesaid personally appeared Moses Self sen[?] [pension application W19009] an old Revolutionary soldier and pensioner of the United States and made oath in due form of law that he was acquainted with Teliff Alverson and knew that the said Teliff Alverson enlisted in the Revolutionary War at the early part thereof under Capt [first name undeciphered] Parker and went into Regular Service and was in the long Bridge Battle [Battle of Great Bridge, 9 Dec 1775] do Believe that the said Alverson served out his full Term of enlistment which was for three years Given under my hand this [date undeciphered] 1831
