At a Court held for James City County March the 10<sup>th</sup> 1783  
A Certificate from Colo. Charles Harrison of Continental Artillery of Robert Anderson' having served as a  
Matross in his Regiment three years, the Term of his Enlistment was produced and read. And the said  
Anderson made Oath that he never before pressed his Claim to Land for the said Service or received any  
satisfaction for the same, which is ordered to be certified and recorded
