July the 22<sup>d</sup> 1789


Samuel Applebee enlisted in Captain William Washington's company the 16 day August 1776 in the third Virginia Regiment

Died the last of December 1786 [possibly 1781]

John Hore Sergent in the third Virginia regiment  
W Washington formerly Captain in the 3<sup>d</sup> V Reg't  
G Weedon MG [George Weedon Major General]

A Land warrant wanted for this.

Prince William Sc.

George Appleby made oath before me [undeciphered] Graham a Justice of peace for s'd County –  
That he has never received a Warrant for any Land that his Son Sam'l. Appleby is or was intitled to on  
Account of the within Certificate.

Given under my hand this 7<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1791 Rich'd Graham
