Know all men by these presents that I Cornelius Bachelor private & waggoner [page torn] Third
Reg't. Light Dragoons Do nominate, institute and appoint Rich'd [illegible] Esq'r my Lawful Attorney to
transact and receive the pay due me from the United States for my services in s'd Reg't.
given under my hand this 3rd Day of July 1786
