Henrico County Court April 1784

Burwell Bacon appeared in Court [undeciphered word] the Court to understand that he is brother & heir at Law to Lyddall Bacon, late a Soldier in the Continental Line, Whereupon Nathaniel Wilkinson being sworn deposes that the said Burwell is heir at Law to the said decedent to the best of his knowledge having heard that Jno. Bacon who was heir at Law to the said Decedent is also dead Whereupon the same is ordered to be Certified.
