


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

Pittsylvania I certify that Ansalum Baley was a Soldier in the sixth Virginia Regt on continental establishment; and that he died, while in that Service. Given under my Hand this 28th Day of October 1811. [James Johnson]
Late Major in the 6th Vir. reg't
on Continental establishment.

A Warrant for 100 ac[re]s is[sue]d to Anselm Bailey [Ansolem Bailey S37702] for 3 yrs service in the State line Dec'r 5th 1783.
also a Warrant for 100 acs is'd to Anselm Bailey for 3 years service in the Cont'l line. Jan'y 2nd 1811. No other warrant or warrants appear to have iss'd for the military service of Anselm Bailey
