Sir You will be Please to grant to Capt John Hudson a Warrant for what ever land may be due me for my Services in the 2^d Virginia State Regiment, under Command of Colo [Charles] Dabney.

Serjeant Henry Ballance of the [illegible] State Regiment having served the term of three years for which he was enlisted is hereby discharg'd the service. Given under my had at [undeciphered] this first day of May 1780
