I Thos. Bonney [Thomas Bonney S6688] Certify that Edward Bonney a soldier of the revolutionary war enlisted in Capt. Matthews [Thomas Mathews W17076 and R16019] company and served three years and was honourably discharged Given under my hand July 9<sup>th</sup> 1832 Thomas hisXmark Bonney

Princess Ann [sic: Princess Anne] County to wit:

I Jon'a Hunter hereby certify that Thomas Bonney this day made oath to the above certificate before me  
Given under my hand and seal this 9<sup>th</sup> July 1832 Jon'a Hunter J.P.

I Fra's Ayres [Francis Ayres] aged 74 years certify that I knew Edward Bonney a soldier of the revolution that he enlisted in Capt. Thos. Mathews company and served several years  
Given under my hand this 10<sup>th</sup> July 1832. Fra's hisXmark Ayres
