I Malachi Carroll [S8180] aged 78 years Certify that I knew Jno Brown a soldier of the revolutionary war. I certify that he enlisted as a Fifer in the Va. State line but can not say how long he served as I was carried to the Southward after he enlisted and did not return untill after [the] war Given under my hand this [illegible] 1832  
Malachi hisXmark Carroll

I Wm Cannon [William Cannon] Certify that John Brown a Soldier of the revolutionary War, entered in Augustine Tabbs company upwards of five years, as fifer, and was honourably discharged at the end of the war. Given under my hand July 3<sup>rd</sup> 1832



I Thos Bonney [Thomas Bonney S6688] certify that I knew John Brown a Soldier of the revolutionary war. I further certify that I have always understood that the aforesaid Jno Brown served to the end of the war, as a fifer. Given under my hand in Princess Ann [sic: Princess Anne County VA] this 9<sup>th</sup> July 1832.
