Thomas Bonny [Thomas Bonney S6688] a Revolutionary [one or two undeciphered words] Soldier [undeciphered word] Princess Anne County State of Virginia now drawing a pension from the United States the sum of sixty dollars per year and being in [undeciphered word] seventy third year of age doth Certify that I knew Isaak Barnes who was a soldier in the Revolutionary War of the United States Continental Line. I saw him in service he enlisted Dureing the war and saw him after the end of the war he walked lame from a wound which he received from the enemy [in] his hip and I verially believe he served to the end of the war as witness my hand and seal this Second day of May in the year 1833
