Kentucky [several undeciphered words] Daniel Barnett appeared before me a Justice of the peace [several illegible words] and made oath that he Enlisted in Virginia in the year 1779 or 1780 for during the war in Capt [undeciphered] Company in the 7<sup>th</sup> Virginia Regiment Commanded by Col [undeciphered] and he continued to serve in said Corps until the year [several undeciphered words]

Sworn to and Subscribed before me this 6<sup>th</sup> day of Sept 18[??]

Kentucky Madison County Sct [19 Sep 1821]

Elisha Eastes [W9419] appeared before me a Justice of the Peace for said County and made Oath that he was well acquainted with the above named Daniel Barnett in the Revolutionary War and well knows that said Daniel Barnett did Enlist for Three years and served that period and was honorably discharged & that afterwards said Barnett Enlisted for during the War and did serve to the End thereof as he has stated in his Affidavit within and was again discharged.
