I James Bullifant [James Bullefant S39236] of the County of Charles City state of Va. do hereby certify that I am about eighty two years of age, that Peter Barrow enlisted with me in the war of the revolution and served two years and until his death, under Capt Wm. Gregory [William Gregory] of the sixth Virginia regiment; that said Barrow had nearly served out the term of two years for which he enlisted before his death. Given under my hand and seal this the 18<sup>th</sup> July 1833.
