These are to certify that Henry Barton formerly a Soldier in the 8<sup>th</sup> Virginia Regiment has duly & faithfully served the term of three years for which he was enlisted. In consequence of which and at his own request he is hereby discharged from any further service in the Army of the united States and permitted to return to his home free and unmolested he having received all his bounty, pay and Cloathing and deficiency of pay & Cloatheing in full [undeciphered word] allowance, and [several illegible words] Congress for their Troops his receipt for which is on the back hereof.

Given under my hand at Philadelphia this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of February 1780.
