THIS is to certify that William Barvent a Sergent & [undeciphered word] Forage Master [two or three undeciphered words] in the First Partisan Legion, under my Command, has served faithfully & Bravely [one or two undeciphered words] to this Day, is hereby discharged from the Service of the United States, in Pursuance of Orders received from the Commander in Chief, bearing Date the third instant.

I farther certify that William Barvent a Sergent & Forage Maser of the Legion having been Enlisted in the State of Virginia is intituled by the Resolution of Congress, of the 13th February, 1779, to the Benefits that have been, or hereafter shall be, granted by the said State to the Noncommissioned Officers and Soldiers of the said Line.

Given under my Hand and Seal at York Town, this fifteenth Day of November, 1783.


