I do Certify that Thomas Sandy Inlisted in the State Regiment of Artillery under Major John Mazaret [sic: John Mazarett R16059] in Feby 1778, and was Discharged from the said Regiment in Feby 1781 after serving Three years, faithfully the time he Inlisted to serve, Given under my hand at Urbanna this 12<sup>th</sup> day of June 1796.
