

Fayette County Penn'a. 10<sup>th</sup> June 1819

I Uriah Springer [R10017] late a Capt'n in the 13<sup>th</sup> Virginia Regiment on Continental establishment in the war of the revolution do hereby Certify that Edward Beeson was an Ensign in the 8<sup>th</sup> Virg'a Reg;t and that he died at the Hospital of Bethleham [sic: Bethlehem] in the State of Penn'a in the year 1778 whilst he was serving in s'd Reg't as Ensign
