I Certify that Mercer Beeson was an enlisted Soldier in Cappt. Robert Bealls [Robert Beall BLWt431-300] Company of the thirteenth Virg'a Regiment on Continental establishment, and that he died in service at the Yellow Spring Hospital [near Chester Springs PA] in the Winter of 1777-78 and that he had been enlisted for during the war.

Given under my hand this 10th day of Sept'r 1817.
