

I do certify that Captain Thomas Bell has been in the continental Service from the 8<sup>th</sup> of march 1777 untill the 21<sup>st</sup> of Jan'y 1781 when he became a supernumarey [sic: supernumerary] by a Resolve of Congress Reducing the [several illegible words]

Given under my hand this 7<sup>th</sup> of April 1783 [last digit not clear]
