I do Certify that William Bell was Enlisted by me to serve three years in the Army of the United States and that his time of service Expired Feb'y 20th 1780. C. Page [Carter Page W2161]

I do Certify that William Bell served his full term of three years as a sold in Colo. Baylors [George Baylor W5966] Dragoons Signed 12 Aug't 1784 C. Page f[orme]r Capt L.D. [Light Dragoons]
