

I hereby Certify that William Bernard late of the Seventh Virginia Regiment on Continental establishment was a Lieutenant therein and acted in that Capacity at the time of his Death.

Given under my hand this 5<sup>th</sup> day of June 1783

7<sup>th</sup> Virg'a Reg't
