I do Certify that Captain Lieutenant John Blair was an officer of the Virginia Continental Artillery when he was killed at Sumpters defeat the 18th of August 1780 [defeat of Gen. Thomas Sumter at Fishing Creek SC, 18 Aug 1780] after Serviving [serving] from January 1777
and his heir is entitled to his land William Davies
