


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

This may Certify that Samuel Blair was inlisted by Lt. Thady Kelly [Thaddeus Kelly] to serve as a Soldier in my Ind't Comp'y [Independent Company] in the state of Virg'a for the term of three years which time he hath servd as a good Soldier he is hereby Hon'bly discharged the service
Given under my Hand at Fort Pitt this 31st day May 1780
Henry Heth [VAS456] Capt.

This Day — and made Oath that sometime in December 1779 he recruited three Soldiers for the Virg'a line on Continental establishment and paid them the bounty allowed by the State of Virg'a and that his Papers and Vouchers relative to the above enlistments were lost, or destroyed by the Enemy.

Sir Please to deliver to Mr. John Tanahill such Certificates of pay & other Allowance of Land as is due to me by the Gov't of Virg'a for my service as a Soldier in Cap Heths Comp'y for which this shall be a full acquittance. Witness my hand & seal Ap'1 10 1785
